*****A nail of the horse shoe which is embedded in the steps of the ghat is an object of special reverence for devotees, considered to be of Brahma's horse, while going for Ashwamedha Yajna. ***On the completion of the Yajna, the** forests of Utpalaranya, became known as Brahmavarta, from which the popular name, Bithoor is derived. ***In later centuries Brahmavarta** flourished as the capital of the kingdom of Utpalaranya, over which ruled the emperor Uttanpad. The place is pointed out to be Dhruva Teela.
